

3 Overview

The **PT-4 iREX** is an IR repeater that lets you control up to four machines¹ via their remote control transmitters from a distance.

In particular, the PT-4 iREX:

- Lets you operate machines that are stacked away in closets, cabinets, and even other rooms
- Can operate at a distance of approximately 75 meters² (between the controlled machine and the **PT-4 iREX**)
- Has an IR sensor
- Has an external IR receiver³ which lets you control the **PT-4 iREX** from a distance⁴ of approximately 30 meters⁵
- Is 12V DC fed

To achieve the best performance:

- Connect only good quality connection cables, thus avoiding interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables)
- Avoid interference from neighboring electrical appliances that may adversely influence signal quality and position your Kramer PT-4 iREX away from moisture, excessive sunlight and dust



Caution – No operator-serviceable parts inside unit.

Warning – Use only the Kramer Electronics input power wall adapter that is provided with this unit⁶.

Warning – Disconnect power and unplug unit from wall before installing or removing device or servicing unit.

4 **Your IR Repeater**




Figure 1: PT-4 iREX IR Repeater

Figure 1 and Table 1 define the PT-4i REX unit:

Table 1: Features and Functions of the PT-4 iREX

| # | Feature | Function |
|---|---------------------------|--|
| 1 | OUT 3.5mm Mini Connector | Connect to the IR emitter cable (from 1 to 4) |
| 2 | 12V DC | +12V DC connector for powering the unit |
| 3 | EXT. 3.5mm Mini Connector | Connect to an external remote IR receiver unit for controlling the machine via an IR remote controller (instead of using the front panel IR receiver) ¹ |
| 4 | IR IN | IR sensor red glass window |
| 5 | SIGNAL LED | Lights when an IR link is established |
| 6 | ONLED | Lights when the unit is powered |

5 Connecting the PT-4 iREX IR Repeater

To connect the **PT-4 iREX** *IR Repeater*, as illustrated in the example in Figure 3, do the following:




Figure 2: Connecting the IR Emitter

- 1. Connect the OUT¹, 3.5mm mini connector (from 1 to 4) to the following IR receivers² via the IR emitter cable (see Figure 2):
 - OUT 1 to a DVD player
 - OUT 2 to a video player
 - OUT 3 to an amplifier
 - OUT 4 to a plasma display
- 2. Connect the 12V DC power adapter to the power socket and connect the adapter to the mains electricity.

To operate any of the connected machines, use a remote control³ pointed to the IR Repeater⁴ that is located at a place of your convenience. The IR signal from the remote control is transmitted from the **PT-4 iREX**, via an IR emitter cable, to the appropriate machine.




Figure 3: Connecting the IR Repeater

An external Remote IR receiver can be connected¹ to the EXT. connector, letting you control the **PT-4 iREX** from a distance² of approximately 30 meters.
